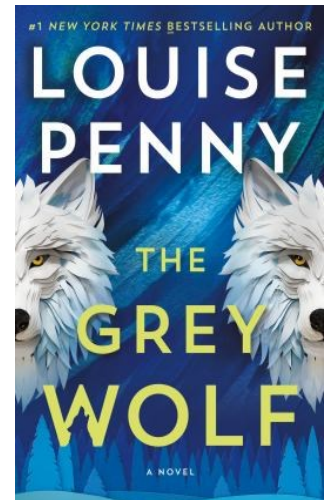

MYSTERY FICTION BOOK OF THE MONTH

"The Grey Wolf" by Louise Penny, the 19th book in her Chief Inspector Gamache series, follows Gamache as he investigates a series of unsettling events that begin with a missing coat and cryptic notes, leading him to uncover a large-scale, potentially devastating plot that crosses international borders, forcing him to confront old allies with suspicion and chase a shadowy threat alongside his trusted team, including his son-in-law Jean-Guy Beauvoir and Inspector Isabelle Lacoste, as they race against time to prevent a catastrophic attack; the story is characterized by a sense of unease and the exploration of duality between good and evil, all set against the backdrop of the peaceful village of Three Pines.

A- Of course! We supply a cover page and it is just a dollar a page to fax. We do not charge for our cover page.

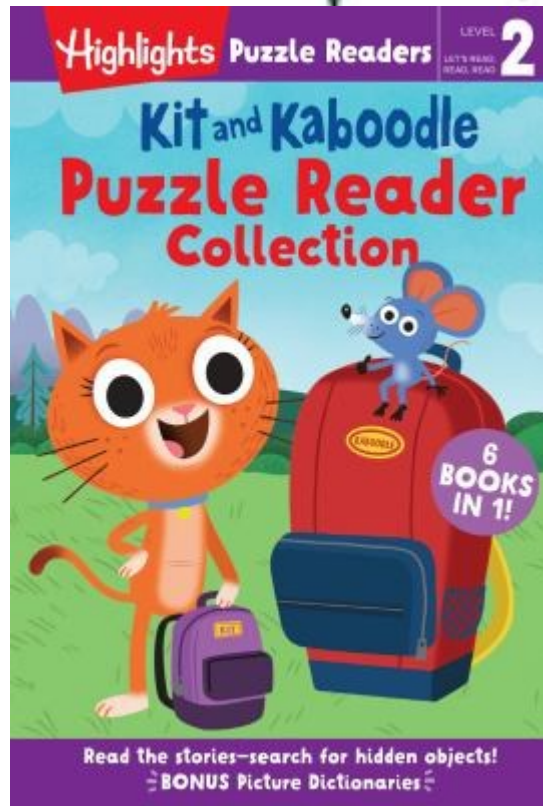
Q- Do you take credit cards?

There are 6 readers in this one big book!

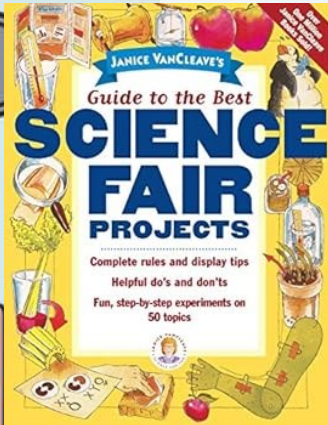

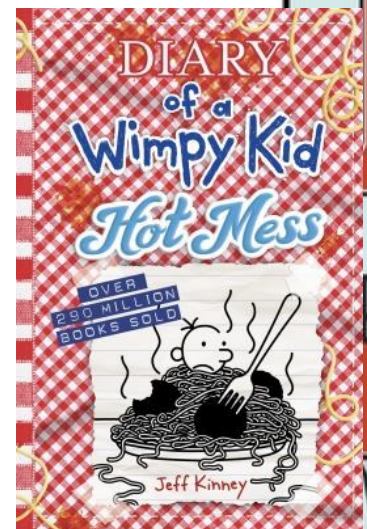


TWEEN READS!
